Oleson Road Bridge Replacement

The Oleson Road Bridge Replacement Project now has an anticipated construction start date of June 2014. This project will replace the bridge over Fanno Creek with a new bridge built above the creek's flood level. Additional improvements include sidewalks, bike lanes, landscaping, street lighting, and storm and drainage facilities. In order to replace the bridge, Oleson Road will need to be closed to vehicle traffic at Fanno Creek for approximately eight months. A temporary pedestrian bridge will be installed during the closure allowing access for walkers and bicyclists during the closure. It is anticipated that the closure will begin in July 2014. Once the contractor is selected for this project, exact dates will be determined and the public will be notified.
